## Animal Health Policy

Approved 5/8/2024

The McLean County Fair Animal Health Committee will handle ALL animal health concerns with ANY species in animal-related events on the fairgrounds during the McLean County Fair (including 4-H, FFA, open class, etc.)

Amanda Huettl, representing FFA, McLean County Fair Board, Open Show

Ashley Giedd-Wooley, representing the McLean County Fair Board, Open Show

Kathy Baer, representing the McLean County open 4-H Horse Show

The Committee will follow the North Dakota State Fair (NDSF) Exhibitor Handbook, NDSF Association Breed Horse Show Book, and International Association of Fairs and Expositions (IAFE) National Code of Show Ring Ethics, and all mandates from the ND State Board of Animal Health.

- Exceptions are:
  - o There will be no vet checks prior to unloading animals upon arrival.
  - o There will be no mandatory drug testing (Ex: Champion and reserve champions.)

Veterinarian on Call:

All decisions made by the veterinarian on call are final.
